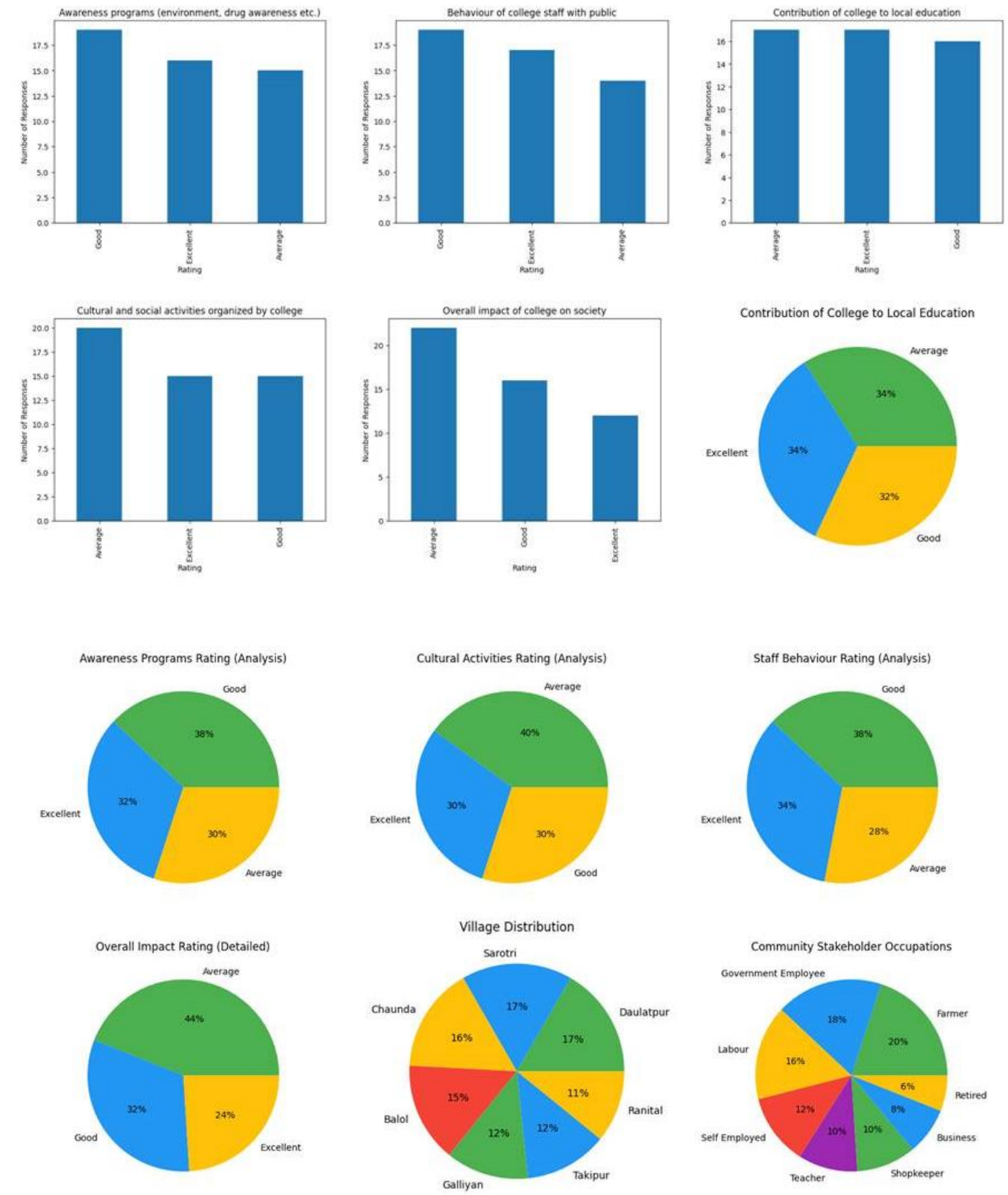
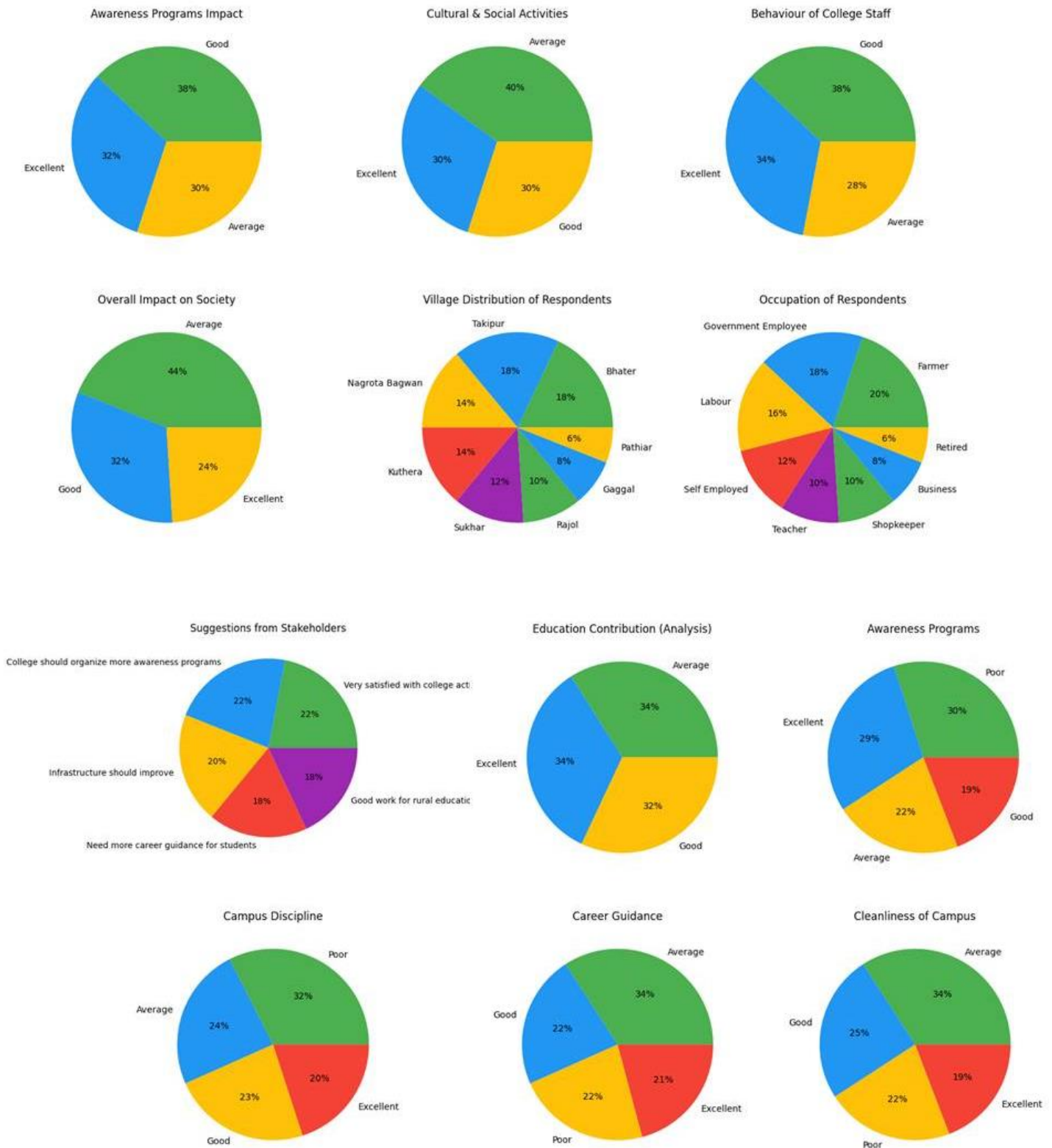


4.17 Feedback from stack holders other than students and action taken thereon





Action Taken Report

The college collected feedback from stakeholders belonging to nearby villages including Takipur, Daulatpur, Chaunda, Balol, Sarotri, Galliyan and Ranital. The feedback was obtained through structured questionnaires covering academic environment, infrastructure, community activities, and overall institutional impact.

Major Findings from Stakeholder Feedback

- Stakeholders appreciated the role of the college in providing higher education opportunities to rural youth.
- Awareness programs related to environment, drug de-addiction and social issues were positively acknowledged.
- Cultural and social activities conducted by the college were considered beneficial for student development.
- Most stakeholders rated the behaviour of college staff as cooperative and supportive.
- The institution was recognized as an important educational centre contributing to the development of surrounding villages.

Action Taken by the College

- Strengthening of ICT facilities and computer laboratories to improve digital learning.
- Enhancement of library resources with additional reference books and learning material.

- Improvement of campus facilities including playground development and infrastructure maintenance.
- Encouragement of cultural, sports and co-curricular activities for holistic student development.
- Improved interaction with local community and Panchayat bodies for institutional development.
