(i) Green initiatives of the institution

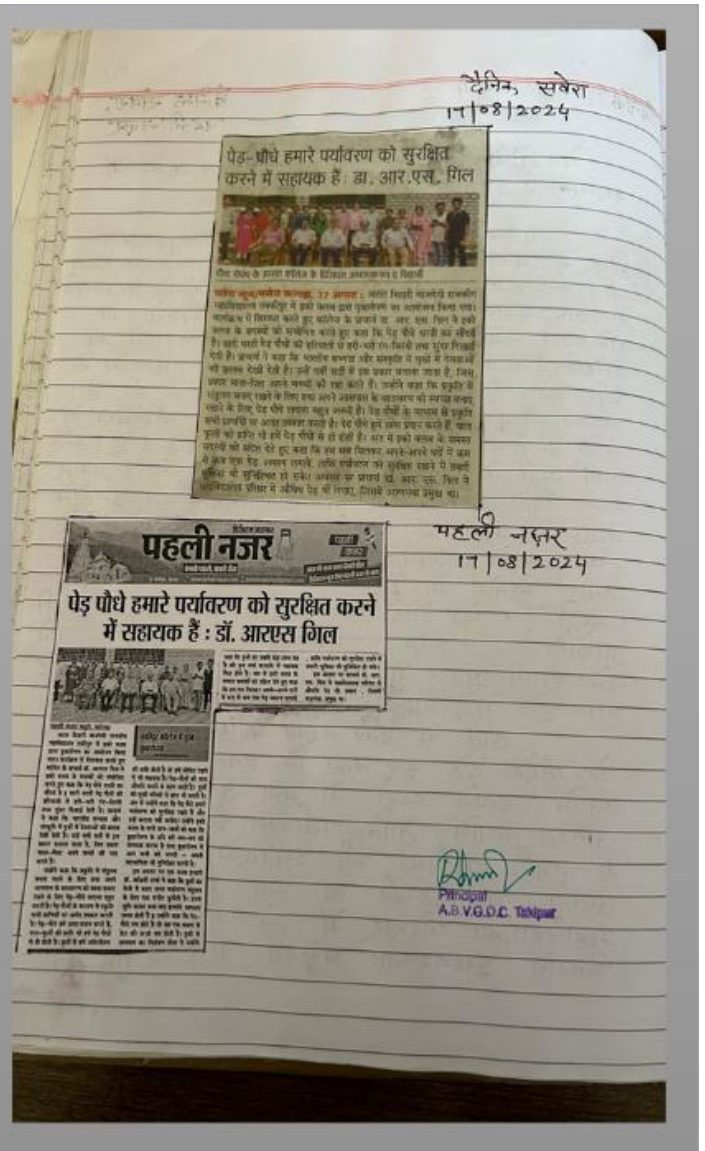
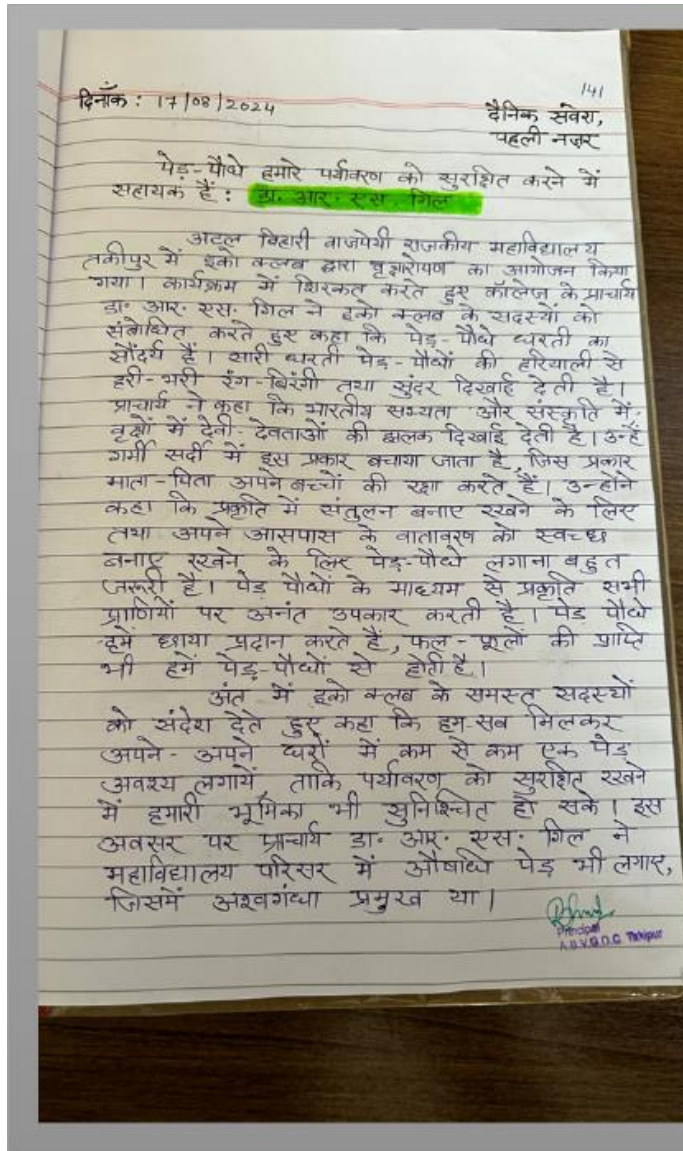
(a) Rain water harvesting

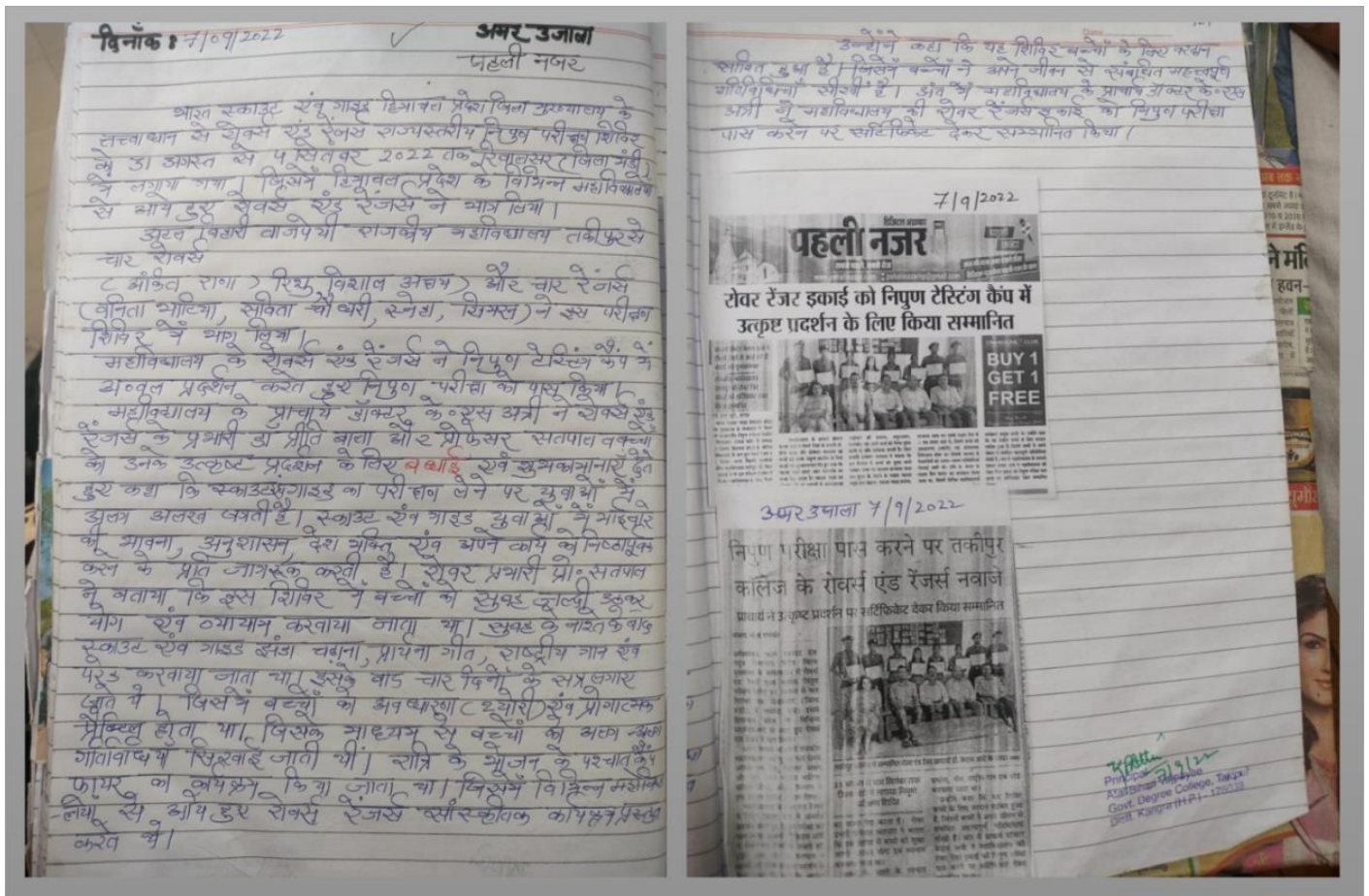

An electric motor has been installed to uplift the water and supply it to the other corridors of the college campus. This is routinely used to water the plants in the summer season. This has also been used for construction purposes as well.

Plantation drives for planting a certain variety of plants in the college campus were conducted during the past years and this year as well. A variety of plants are found in the campus like the *Cycas*,



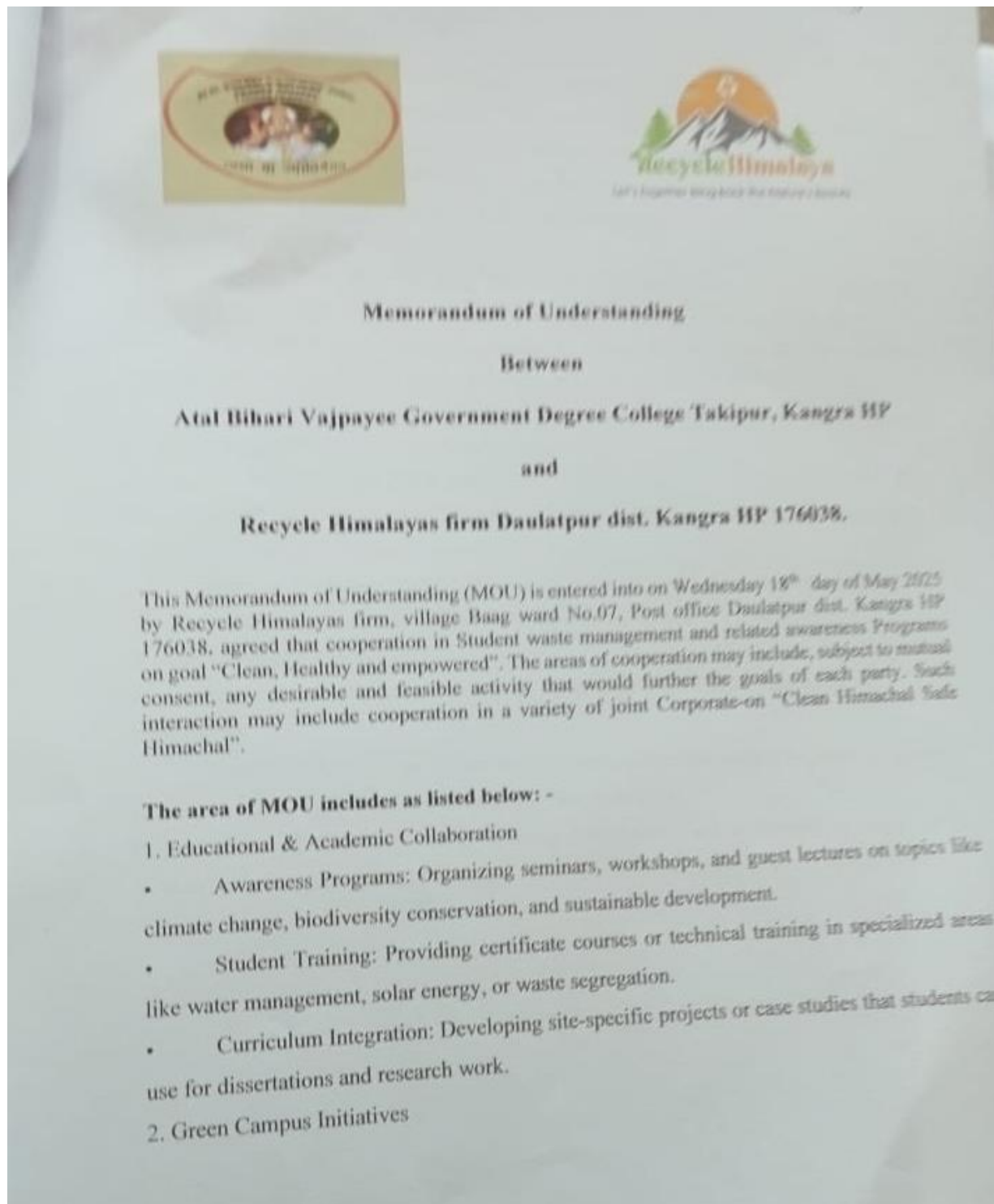


(c) MoU for Sustainable Waste Management and Green Campus Initiatives

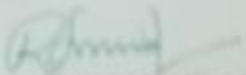
