Following are the different attempts made by the faculty members to use latest methods and technologies in the teaching-learning process.

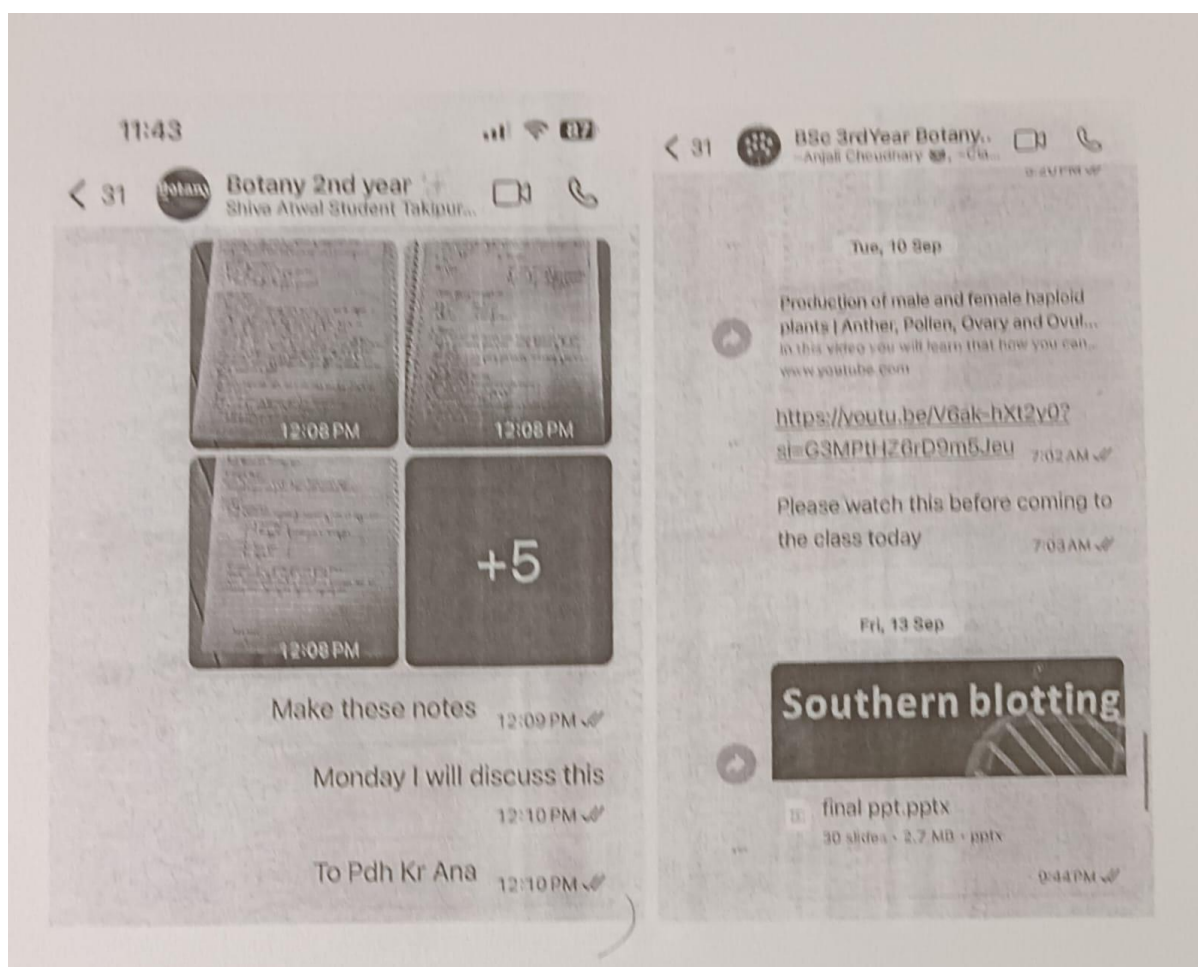
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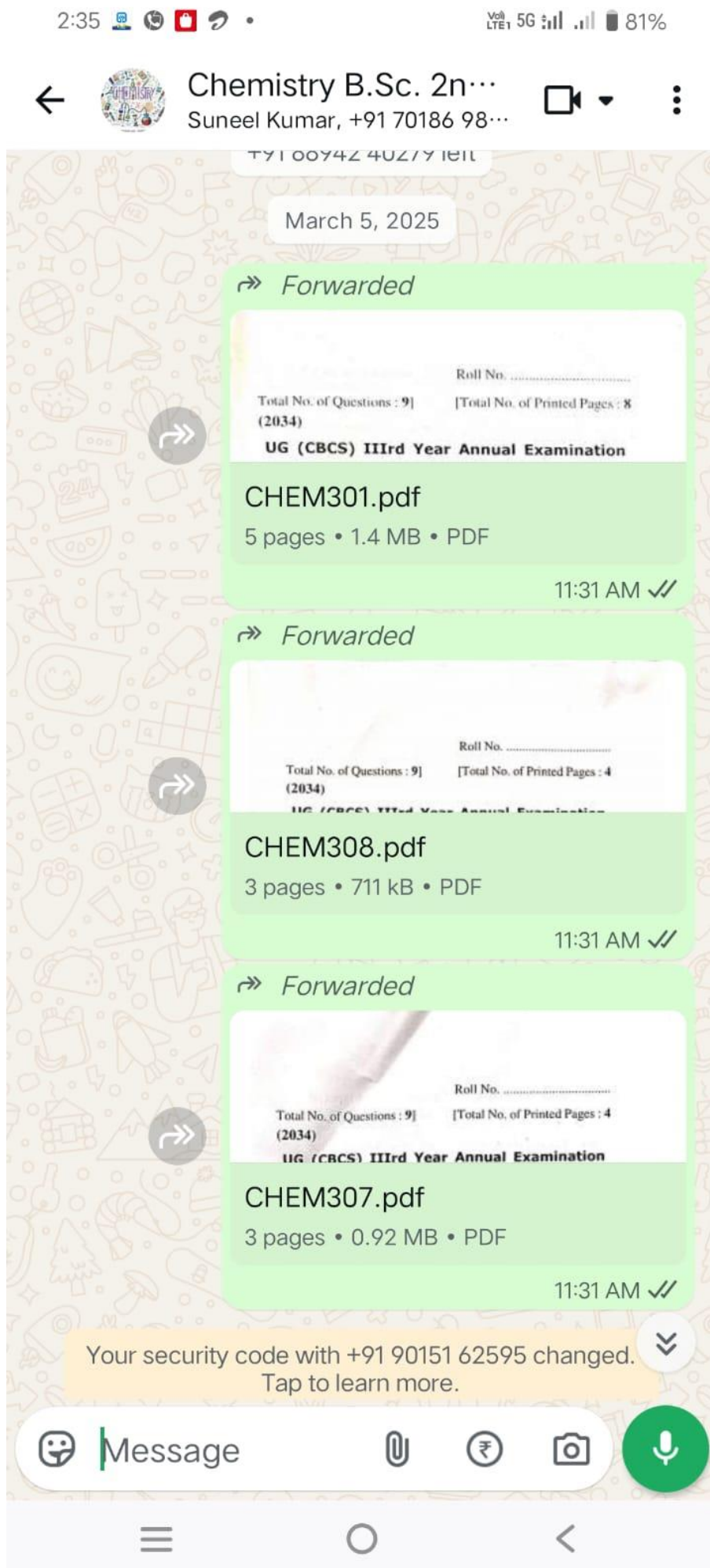


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
